As you know, AAAE is trying to ride a fine line of making Durbin and Lautenberg happy and maintaining allies like Ford. So, AAAE is trying to develop draft guidelines that will comply with Durbin's issues, yet accommodate all persons who use public airports.

The way AAAE reads Durbin's request to them is: appreciation of the diversity of airport control (state and local authorities), and interest in enforcement of laws that are in place and clear directions/signs to help passengers and others determine nonsmoking areas.

AAAE's guidelines will make recommendations to their members on a policy of accommodation of both smokers and nonsmokers within the limits of the law in their area.
