It's a surprise!



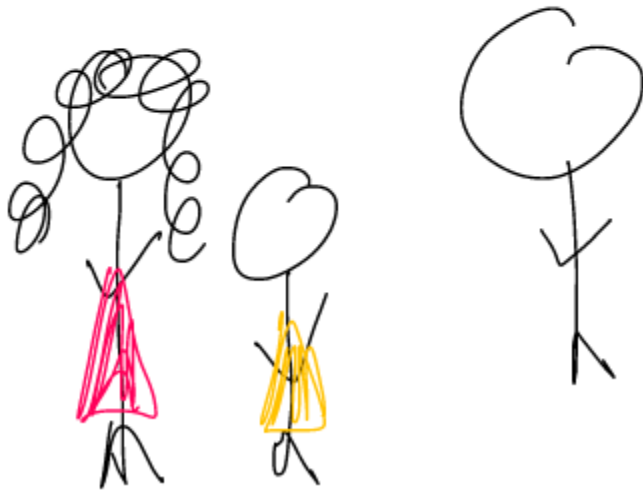

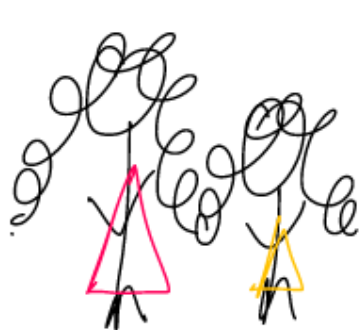

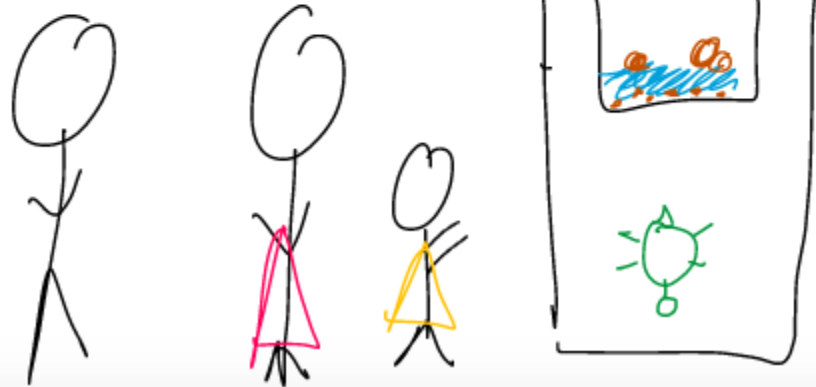

They can also pop their head in and out of their shell like those whack-a-mole games in order to hide from predators.



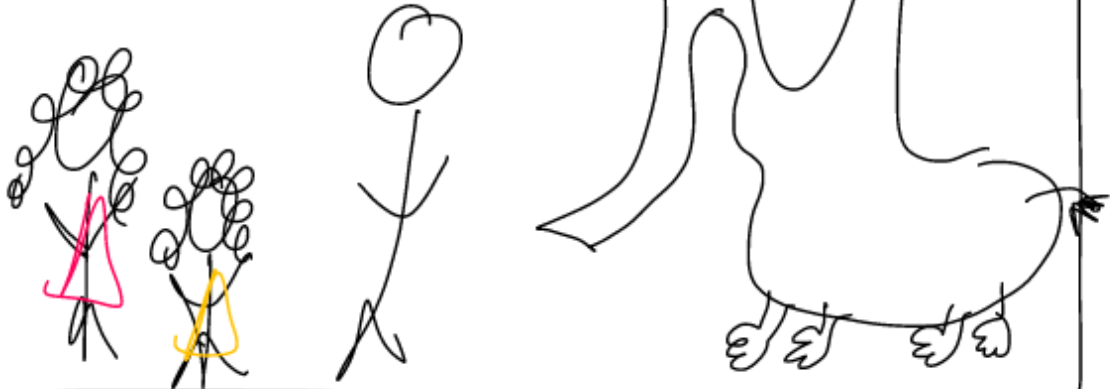
The last animal we'll be seeing today Mrs. Elephant!
