Below is my report for November, 1991.

Fair Taxes - I presented the fair tax materials to the Plantation Democratic Club who invited me to make the presentation. The Plantation Democratic Club has a membership of approximately 425 people made up of democratic activists and political leaders. We discussed the ramifications of the invasion of employee privacy.

I presented the fair tax materials to Local 2315 Professional Firefighters of Davie, Florida. We discussed the impact of employee privacy and the employer invasion of privacy.

I attended the 21st Century Democratic luncheon on November 19. The luncheon was structured around taxes for Florida. I contact C.T. J. in Washington to have a speaker for the panel. Doug Kelly had suggested Bruce Fisher, but unfortunately at the last moment Bruce developed pneumonia and could not attend. I filled in and passed out copies of the C.T.J. release on fair taxes for Florida. The panel discussion went well with everyone's input. The panelists were:

- Dr. Neil Crispo - Florida Tax Watch
- Hugh Anderson - Appointed to Tax Commission by the Governor's office.

I had a press conference on Wednesday, November 20, at 12 noon at the Governmental Center in Fort Lauderdale, Florida. The press conference was held in conjunction with the Florida Consumer Federation and there was a press conference in West Palm Beach at the same time. Enclosed you will find the press package.

IAQ - I am working with Jim Carey from Washington N.E.M.I. and Ogilvy, Rinehart and Adams on the OSHA request for comments to the Federal Register.

I am contacting the Florida State AFL-CIO plus the locals I have already made presentations to for their input on IAQ.

I attended a COPE meeting in Orlando, Florida, for all the Presidents and COPE Directors along with the National AFL-CIO and made them aware of the OSHA requests.
