GFA: In #10, Akpabli is commanding his enemy to come out and meet him. "Whoever you think you are, whatever you want, come out and let's see." Those were war times. All these songs deal with war issues, but nowadays you can take it like a test between friends. Maybe you and a friend are good drummers, so you say, "Come and let's do it and see who it better." We can put it in different terms, if we want to convert the warrior issues to our social life. We can do that later; that is why I consulted with Mr. Dewornu and my uncles for advice. I will tell them other opinions. These days there is no war. We should use some of these frames in a different format so that people can understand what can be done in the modern life. We are not in Iran or Iraq, but the original people in Anlo state will go for the warrior messages that tell them exactly what their forefathers have done before.
