CITIZEN TAX WATCHDOGS TO EXAMINE FUNDING PROPOSALS FOR MINNESOTACARE

ST. PAUL— Which is the fairest funding proposal for MinnesotaCare? To help answer this question, Minnesota Citizens for Tax Justice (MCTJ) will release its new report on MinnesotaCare funding at a 9:00 a.m. press conference on Tuesday, April 11, in room 181 of the State Office Building in St. Paul. <u>Please note that the conference time has been moved ahead one hour from its originally scheduled time</u>.

The report, compiled by the nonpartisan tax research organization MCTJ, will assess the different funding proposals being considered for expanding MinnesotaCare and will indicate which proposal is fairest to state taxpayers.

MCTJ Executive Director Wayne Cox will present the report on behalf of the taxpayer watchdog group whose member organizations include the Minnesota AFL-CIO, Minnesota Farmers Union, Minnesota Senior Federation and a number of other civic and labor organizations.
