At last count, we were working with more than 3,100 fire service groups in the U.S. in all 50 states. In many instances, we have encouraged elected officials to work with fire fighters and The Institute on cooperative fire safety ventures.

Although our program has helped us with this issue, I sincerely hope you do not have to face it in Great Britain. However, if it erupts in your country, we will be happy to provide whatever guidance you require.
