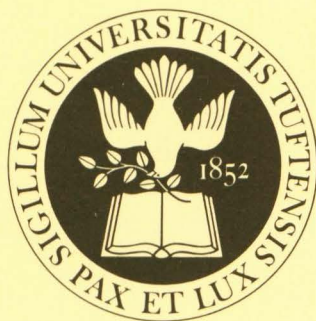

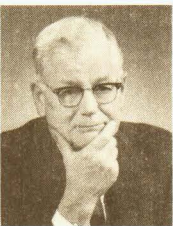

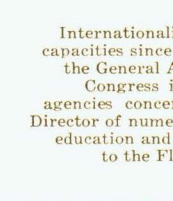
**LAWRENCE GRAHAM BROOKS (L.H.D.)** Presiding justice, First District Court of Eastern Middlesex; presiding justice, Appellate Division, District Court for the Northern District of Massachusetts. Director, United Community Services of Greater Boston and World Affairs Council of Massachusetts. Director and officer of numerous civic and financial institutions; former board chairman, American Unitarian Association; former vice-moderator and trustee of Unitarian-Universalist Association. 1965 recipient of Rogerson Award from United Community Services.



**WILLIAM VENERANDO CONSOLAZIO (Sc.D.)** Senior staff associate, Office of Program Development and Analysis, National Science Foundation. Former head of the Chemistry Department of the Naval Medical Research Institute and of the Biochemistry Branch of the Office of Naval Research. Researcher in biochemistry, molecular biology, environmental physiology. Director of a major study of Federal support for all basic research in Government agencies; actively involved in the formulation of a national policy for research and education in science and engineering. Tufts graduate, 1933.



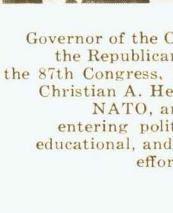
**FREDERICK JOHNSON (Sc.D.)** Archeologist; curator, Robert S. Peabody Foundation for Archeology at Phillips Academy, Andover. Over the years he has conducted wide-ranging archeological researches in North America, the Arctic, and Central America. Pioneer in developing the multi-disciplinary approach to archeology, as well as the radiocarbon method of dating. Past president, Society for American Archeology; former executive secretary, American Anthropological Association; member or fellow of numerous national scientific societies. Tufts graduate, 1929.



**MARY PILLSBURY LORD (L.H.D.)** Internationalist. U. S. representative to the United Nations in various capacities since 1947, including UNICEF and eight successive sessions of the General Assembly. Member of the U. S. Delegation to the Atlantic Congress in 1959. During World War II chairman or director of agencies concerned with women's participation and civilian defense. Director of numerous organizations involving international affairs and the education and employment of women. Member of the Board of Visitors to the Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy in Tufts University.



**ROBERT JOSEPH MANNING (Litt.D.)** Editor, the *Atlantic Monthly*. Assistant Secretary of State for Public Affairs, 1962-64. Chief, London Bureau, *Time*, *Life*, and *Fortune* magazines, 1958-61; writer and senior editor, *Time*, 1949-58; founder, United Press United Nations Bureau and chief U.N. correspondent, 1946-49; State Department and White House correspondent, United Press, 1944-46. Nieman Fellow, Harvard University, 1945-46. Director, International Development Foundation and World Affairs Council of Boston. Member, Board of Visitors to the Edward R. Murrow Center in the Fletcher School of Tufts University.



**WILLIAM WARREN SCRANTON (LL.D.)** Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania since 1962. Candidate for the Republican nomination for president of the U. S., 1963. Member of the 87th Congress, 1960-62. Former special assistant to Secretary of State Christian A. Herter; represented U. S. at conferences in Latin America, NATO, and U.N. Banker, lawyer, and corporation director before entering politics; trustee or director of numerous civic, charitable, educational, and religious organizations. A leader in the much publicized effort of Scranton, Pennsylvania, and its surrounding area to revitalize itself since the depletion of anthracite coal.



**KENNETH F. LEACH (B.S. *extra ordinem*)** Engineer. Manager, Boston Regional Office, George A. Fuller Company; he was closely involved in the construction of the Nils Yngve Wessell Library at Tufts. Lieutenant, Corps of Engineers, during World War II. Member of Tufts Class of 1944.
