Below is my report for September, 1991.

Fair Taxes - I visited Local 725 of the U/A Pipefitters with a membership of 2,500 and presented the fair tax materials to their members.

I presented the fair tax materials to the South Florida Carpenters District Council, which has an affiliation of approximately 4,000 members. The Carpenters were very interested in our program and mentioned that the film, the brochure, and the charts (boards) that we use were helpful and informative.

I presented the fair tax materials to the Tampa Central Labor Council, which has a membership of 80,000. The Central Labor Council is representative of many unions in five counties.

I presented the fair tax materials to Local 971 of the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers who represent workers at Pratt Whitney in Palm Beach. Local 971 has a membership of 1,300.

IAQ - I presented the Indoor Air Quality materials to the International Association of Machinists District 100 Convention, which has a membership of 3,500 and passed an Indoor Air Quality Resolution.


I presented the Indoor Air Quality materials to the Florida State Council of Machinists, which has a membership of 14,000 and passed the Indoor Air Quality Resolution.
