WITH LAST MONTH'S ADJOURNMENT OF THE MINNESOTA STATE LEGISLATURE, THINGS HAVE BEEN RELATIVELY CALM. HOWEVER, THE VENDING MACHINE ISSUE CONTINUES TO BE A FACTOR SINCE LOCAL COMMUNITIES MAY ADOPT ORDINANCES STRONGER THAN THE NEW STATE LAW.

CONSEQUENTLY, I HAVE BEEN SPENDING TIME WITH THE CITY COUNCILS IN THE COMMUNITIES OF HASTINGS, SOUTH ST. PAUL, VIRGINIA, MOUNTAIN IRON, AND HIBBING. THESE CITIES ARE CONSIDERING LANGUAGE STRONGER THAN THE NEW STATE LAW, AND I HAVE MADE MY PRESENCE KNOWN TO THE APPROPRIATE PERSONS.

NEXT MONTH WILL BE STATE PARTY CONVENTIONS, WHERE I INTEND TO CONTINUE TALKING WITH VARIOUS POLITICAL LEADERS, BOTH ESTABLISHED AS WELL AS POTENTIAL INDIVIDUALS.
