<u>Agreed Positions on Post-Referendum Security</u> <u>Arrangements and Issues</u>

- 1. The representatives of the Government of the Republic of Sudan (GOS) and the Sudan People's Liberation Movement (SPLM) (the Parties) in the Security Cluster of the Post-Referendum Arrangements and Issues Negotiating Teams, hereby declare that the Parties have reached agreement on certain security matters as set out in the schedule below.
- 2. The schedule consists of three papers of substantive agreements (items i iii), which shall form part of the final agreement on Security Arrangements and Issues. Item (iv) is a paper identifying security issues on which the cluster requires political guidance from the Lead Negotiating Panel prior to concluding negotiations on the specified issues.
- 3. The Parties commit themselves to reaching timely agreement on all the outstanding issues.
