

Agreed Positions on Post-Referendum Security Arrangements and Issues

The Government of the Republic of Sudan

And

The Sudan People's Liberation Movement

1. The representatives of the Government of the Republic of Sudan (GOS) and the Sudan People's Liberation Movement (SPLM) (the Parties) in the Security Cluster of the Post-Referendum Arrangements and Issues Negotiating Teams, hereby declare that the Parties have reached agreement on certain security matters as set out in the schedule below.
2. The schedule consists of three papers of substantive agreements (items i - iii), which shall form part of the final agreement on Security Arrangements and Issues. Item (iv) is a paper identifying security issues on which the cluster requires political guidance from the Lead Negotiating Panel prior to concluding negotiations on the specified issues.
3. The Parties commit themselves to reaching timely agreement on all the outstanding issues.
