You will find attached the plan that the LMC consultants have pulled together in conjunction with Wayne Cox of Minnesota CTJ, as part of our effort to promote tax fairness messages in that state.

I think it's a sound plan. You'll note that Wayne is prepared to take advantage of a variety of opportunities over the next several days to urge labor support of a progressive tax package for the state. As part of his program, he will encourage his audiences to communicate the progressive tax message to their elected officials.

Please note particularly the eighth activity listed in the plan. You had asked for assistance in reaching out to encourage letters from the building trades unions in the state. We recommend adding the Teamsters to that list. I have approved the drafting of sample letters. However, we believe that Wes Lane is in the best position to encourage that those letters be sent. He has had success with similar efforts in the past -- particularly on the smoking restriction and vending issues.

With your approval, we'll move forward with these latest components of our Minnesota program. I will be happy to answer any questions.
