**SUBJECT:** AFGE/IAQ Activities

Dave Schlein called me late Friday to discuss the following matters:

- Schlein has received a request to meet with LaQuietta Hardy, staff member of the U.S. House Government Activities and Transportation Subcommittee (chaired by Cardiss Collins) of the Committee on Government Operations regarding upcoming oversight hearings on GSA and its handling of the IAQ issue. Hardy attended the SWAC conference and has developed a strong interest in the issue.

No date has yet been set for hearings, but Schlein should get a better idea of scheduling and parameters after his meeting with Hardy tomorrow afternoon.

- Schlein also has been asked to testify June 7, at a hearing of the D.C. City Council's Committee on Consumer and Regulatory Affairs regarding John Ray's Indoor Safe Air Act of 1989, Bill 8-163 (copy attached). The bill primarily addresses the radon problem.

Both of these matters offer Schlein an opportunity to address the IAQ issue before two important forums. We will offer suggestions and ideas for his testimony. In the case of the D.C. City Council, we will offer testimony language to expand the focus beyond radon to ventilation and other IAQ issues. We won't draft the testimony but rather provide some talking points and stylistic advice.
