Fair Taxes

I presented the fair tax materials and the employee privacy issue to the Painters Local Union 1010, on October 13, 1992, with approximately forty members in attendance. The members appreciated the Brochure and the film about Taxes, and were most appreciative of the presentation on Privacy.

I presented the Fair Tax Materials and the Privacy issue to the membership of Local 1591, White Collar Workers in Broward County FL., on October 21, 1992. The membership was very interested in Taxes because of being County Employees, and the effect that Taxes have on their Jobs.

I attended the Union meeting of Local Union 3108, Communications Workers Of America, with Jim Carey, Olgilvy Rinehart and Adams, on October 27, 1992, to present the Safe Indoor Air Quality materials. There were approximately seventy five members in attendance. The membership was well aware of the symptoms that they were experiencing and Sick Building Syndrome. We will be attempting to set up meetings with Management to gain access to their buildings to check them out.

I have been working with the Congressional Open Seat Candidates, regarding their opinions on Taxes. We have been very successful with their responses and I am extremely confident that we will be able to work with them very closely on our issues.

I will be attending the Organizational meeting in Tallahassee, FL, on November 17-19. I Have been assured that Taxes will not be an issue in this special called Session. Our Legislature convenes on February 2, 1992 and ends on April 2, 1992.


