Initiative and Referenda Costs 1991-92

Per your request, I have compiled a summary of projected costs for initiatives and referenda through the end of this year and for 1992. The list includes only those jurisdictions that we are currently aware of. Other jurisdictions may surface that we will have to account for at a later time. The amounts listed below reflect the entire cost to the industry. The Lorillard share of these amounts will depend upon which of the companies choose to participate in each campaign.
