As of right now the following groups have expressed a desire to testify at the OSHA hearing. I have broken the groups into three categories: (1) groups that are in accord with our position; (2) groups with which we can work to reach agreement; (3) groups with which we have very little input. All of these groups are national in scope.

(1)

- \* AFL-CIO
- \* Sheet metal workers/NEMI
- \* BC&T
- \* Machinists (working on them for testimony; MAY just send written submission)

Each of the groups listed above will have significant statements and submissions.

(2)

- \* AFGE
- \* Operating engineers
- \* SEIU
- \* AFSCME

The LMC is working with each of these groups to encourage appropriate testimony.

(3)

- \* AFT (teachers)
- \* Flight attendants

We have very limited contact with these two groups.

As I noted, I will try to give you a follow up on Friday, although it may well be Monday (Forscey just called and said Peg was traveling back here on Friday). Forscey will put the 19 preemption state idea to her.

Anyhow, Forscey and I will try to get back to you Friday and certainly on Monday with follow up, recommendations, etc.
