RE: General Services Administration (GSA) Proposed Restrictions on Smoking in Federal Buildings - Update #1

DATE: July 3, 1986

On June 20, I informed a select group of tobacco industry leaders of the intention of the General Services Administration (GSA) to regulate smoking in 6,800 federal buildings across the country. In that letter, I suggested the deadline for filing your letter of opposition was June 27. It has now been extended to July 21.

If you agree with our position that this proposed restriction is an excessive and abusive use of governmental authority, we ask that you write to the GSA at the following address before July 21:

Also, be sure to refer to the following federal rule designation number in your correspondence:

41 CFR Part 101 - 20

Please take a minute to prepare your letter and send it to the GSA. If you have any questions or would like me to assist you in an effort to get your customers or employees to write to the GSA, give me a call. Your involvement is critical. The "letter count" is almost 10-1 in favor of the regulations. We need to turn that around.
