

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 881**  
**OFFERED BY MR. TRAFICANT**

Page 2, strike lines 17 through 21 and insert the following:

1       (a) **SMOKING PROHIBITION.—**

2           (1) **GENERAL RULE.—**On and after the 180th  
3 day after the date of the enactment of this Act,  
4 smoking shall be prohibited in any indoor portion of  
5 a Federal building, except in areas designated pur-  
6 suant to paragraph (2).

7           (2) **DESIGNATION OF SMOKING AREAS.—**The  
8 head of a Federal agency may permit smoking in a  
9 designated area of a Federal building owned or  
10 leased for use by such agency if such area—

11               (A) is ventilated separately from other por-  
12 tions of the Federal building;

13               (B) is ventilated using a method deter-  
14 mined by the Administrator of General Services  
15 to be at least as effective as the method de-  
16 scribed in subparagraph (A); or

17               (C) is ventilated in accordance with Fed-  
18 eral indoor air quality standards for environ-

Page 5, after line 12, add the following:

1           (4) MILITARY INSTALLATION.—The term "mili-  
2       tary installation" means a base, camp, post, station,  
3       yard, center, homeport facility for any ship, or other  
4       activity under the jurisdiction of the Department of  
5       Defense, including any leased facility. Such term  
6       does not include any facility used primarily for civil  
7       works, rivers and harbors projects, or flood control  
8       projects.
