WASHINGTON — After years of fighting to get cigarettes out of the workplace, Donald Garner is battling to keep smokers in the office.

A growing number of U.S. firms are refusing to hire smokers, and that isn't right, said Garner, a Southern Illinois University-Carbondale law professor.
