Footnotes must conform to *A Manual of Style* (the "Chicago Manual"), or the 13th edition of the *Uniform Legal System of Citation* for legal articles. The *Forum* assumes no responsibility for manuscripts or other materials submitted. Items submitted for consideration should be accompanied by a stamped envelope if their return is desired.
