I addressed a meeting of Citizens' Concerned, a political association to which I belong, regarding excise taxes and rules pertaining to the Clean Indoor Air Act. In both instances, I relayed our position and arguments against expansion on these two issues. Furthermore, I stated how the Teamsters were against unilateral changes in indoor air policy; that these were matters for collective bargaining, and used the Court of Appeals decision as a legal case in point.

I assisted officials in Dakota county to achieve a fair smoking policy in their public government buildings. There had been an ongoing dispute over designated smoking areas. The matter has now been solved with appropriate smoking areas set aside to the satisfaction of all parties.

I anticipate next month that the city of Eagan, MN will hear the recommendations of the smoking task force which will suggest little or no changes on tobacco related issues.
