

Letter to Vin # 22 during flu crisis

Dear Vin

This morning I had a nice message on my iphone from your niece Janice in response to my update to her that she requested. She was very glad that so far there are no cases of the virus at West river where you are. She is staying away from people but does take a walk every day. Yesterday it was right past a junior alligator in the retention pond behind her house. She is healthy and loves seeing nature. Laney and Deanna are both finishing their semester online at home. She is sad for Laney because as a senior there will be no spring graduations in Florida. Janice is hopeful that her class will be added to whenever the next ceremony is. Deanna was going to do the UF summer session in the Dominican Republic and of course that was canceled.

So you are up to date on Janice. I don't know if I did the right thing or not, but I forwarded Janice's message to the various Mainiero cousins: Dick, April, Lynne, Nancy, Bob. I guess I feel badly that there was a rift in your family years ago and that no one has tried to repair it for all, though I know you did for you.

. I find it interesting that Janice's daughter and Pam Wheeler's daughter are both named Deanna. It is uncommon I think. Janice's Deanna was named after her husband Dean.

This afternoon after I sent Rick Mainiero and inquiry since he lives in New York and that has so many people sick and dying, he responded to me. He is grounded in NY. When the shutdown began, he had 7 people from his biotech diagnosing company in India in NYC for launching his company. He lives 1/3 miles from hospital Mt Sinai West that is dealing with some of the worst cases in Manhattan but he says that is not as bad as Queens that has more cases. He does say that the streets are empty. Apparently the research and development for his bio diagnosing company was done in Mumbai and Chennai, and filed last July and August in India and US. They are a start up now trying to do a road show- I guess that means find buyers of their service or product.

I wish I knew where your Brewster Rd title and your birth certificate are. I am trying to put our most important documents in one file that stays on the desk in case either of us dies. I do have your Ed Marcantonio documents and Cody White, and car titles. I have been trying to evaluate the Amica documents and see what needs to be current.
