2018-2019 CHAT Faculty Fellowships

Application Deadline has been extended to March 21, 2018

In 2018-2019, CHAT offers research awards to Arts, Humanities, or Social Science tenure track and tenured faculty in the School of Arts and Sciences at Tufts who are engaged in humanistic scholarship or artistic creation or criticism. The Tufts Faculty Fellows will receive one or two course releases and office space throughout the academic year. Fellows will present their work in a seminar, participate in the research seminar on themes in Comparative Global Humanities, and participate in other activities of the Center. We particularly invite applications from faculty whose creative or scholarly work is interdisciplinary, interdepartmental, and/or fosters cross-campus dialogue.

Applications, consisting of a CV, a 1500-word research proposal, and a letter of support from the applicant's department or program chair, should be submitted by March 21, 2018 to Amalia Teglas at humanities@tufts.edu.

2018-2019 Dean's Graduate Student Dissertation Awards

Application Deadline is March 21, 2018

The CHAT Dean's Graduate Student Dissertation Awards provide support in the dissertation research of two doctoral students working in the humanities and the arts within the Graduate School of Arts and Sciences. Graduate students nominated by the following departments are eligible: Drama and Dance, English, and History. Each fellowship offers a stipend of \$1,350 per month for 9-12 months, with up to an additional \$1,800 if the research is presented at conferences, and upon submission of a final report. Each Fellow is required to submit this report to the Graduate School of Arts and Sciences on the research completed during the fellowship. The maximum award will be \$18,000.
