I have spoken with Dennis Dyer about the attached, and just so there is no misunderstanding, please make sure that Jim Golden knows that:

- 1. Funding for Tiernan's activities on behalf of NEMIC expired on December 31, 1990. Since Tiernan failed to submit reports for his activities during the latter half of 1990, and since funds are no longer available, he will not be compensated for any additional work done in 1990.
- 2. There will be no renewal for 1991. That was made clear when we agreed to renew for one more year in 1990.
- 3. I am told that Sheet Metal Workers want to hire Tiernan to lobby on their behalf in Massachusetts on a variety of issues, including IAQ, plant closing and other matters. That's their prerogative, and their responsibility. That kind of activity will not be part of any NEMI grant, nor will the LMC retain Tiernan in any capacity other than his current one as LMC counsel for New England and New York.

(Dennis expresses some concern -- and I agree -- that Golden should not be attaching his reports to the LMC to correspondence. The arrangement between NEMI and the LMC is none of Tiernan's business and the scope of the work is such that it could cause some embarrassment were it to get out.)
