6	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
7	The provisions of this act shall not apply when the restriction
8	on smoking relates to a bona fide occupational requirement or an
9	applicable collective bargaining agreement which prohibits or allows
10	off-duty use of tobacco products.
11	SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in
12	the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 503 of Title 40, unless there is
13	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
14	A. The sole remedy for any individual claiming to be aggrieved
15	by a violation of Section 1 of this act shall be civil action for
16	damages which shall include all wages and benefits deprived the
17	individual by reason of the violation.
18	B. The court shall award the prevailing party in such action
19	court costs and reasonable attorney fees.
20	SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
21	of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
22	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
23	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
