RE: Getting the Workplace Project Going Again

It appears that one of The Institute's fastest growing concerns is local (municipal and county) ordinances restricting public smoking, particularly in the workplace.

For purposes of organizing our activities against these measures, we have divided the world into four categories:

1. Localities which are likely to have upcoming smoking restrictions but which have never had previous activity.
2. Localities where we are fighting smoking restrictions now.
3. Localities where major smoking restrictions have been passed in recent years.
4. Localities where we defeated smoking restriction proposals (within the past 24 months) but which are likely to come back with new proposals.

Attached are our lists of cities and counties in each category, followed by objectives and tactics for dealing with them. This is meant to be a simple working plan for getting the project going again.

In addition to these localities, we may want to get involved where we are currently facing workplace smoking restrictions at the state level: Florida, Massachusetts, Michigan, New Jersey, New York, and Pennsylvania.
