HENRY BROMFIELD CABOT (L.H.D.) Attorney. Civic leader. Co-author of *Judges and Law Reform*. Engaged in many civic undertakings, including chairmanship of Greek War Relief, which later became Allied War Relief. Elected a trustee of the Boston Symphony Orchestra in 1935, and president of the trustees in 1946, contributing in this role to the continuing cultural enrichment of Boston and the world.

JOHN FREDERICK COLLINS (LL.D.) Mayor, City of Boston. Attorney. State representative and state senator 1946-55. Member, Boston City Council; Register of Probate for Suffolk County. Elected mayor in 1960 in a surprise victory; re-elected in 1964. Principal architect and tireless worker in shaping and building "the new Boston." Recipient of numerous honors for his dynamic administration.



ABIGAIL ADAMS ELIOT (L.H.D.) Educator. Pioneer in the development of modern early childhood education. Director, Nursery Training School of Boston (subsequently Eliot-Pearson School and now Eliot-Pearson Department of Child Study in Tufts) 1922-52. Lecturer and instructor in numerous schools and colleges, including Eliot-Pearson School, 1957-64. Affiliated in leadership positions with a broad range of civic, educational, and social service organizations.

RAYMOND JOSEPH FAY (Ed.D.) Educator. Director, Division of Administrative Services, Connecticut State Department of Education. Director of Research and Field Services, Connecticut Education Association. Member and officer of local and national education associations. Active participant in Tufts alumni affairs, including past chairman, Tufts Alumni Council and Tufts Alumni Fund. Tufts degrees: B.A. 1929, M.A. 1931.



JOSEPH M. HAYMAN, JR. (L.H.D.) Dean emeritus and professor of medicine emeritus, Tufts University School of Medicine. Dean, Tufts School of Medicine, 1953-66. Authority on the role of electrolytes in human physiology, and on tropical medicine. Member and officer of numerous professional and honorary groups; fellow, American Academy of Arts and Sciences. Consultant to Army Surgeon General and Central Office, Veterans Administration. Author of over eighty professional publications.

HOWARD WESLEY JOHNSON (Sc.D.) President, Massachusetts Institute of Technology. Formerly professor of management and dean of the Alfred P. Sloan School of Management, M.I.T.; executive vice president of Federated Department Stores. Fellow, American Association for the Advancement of Sciences; fellow, American Academy of Arts and Sciences; member, Council on Foreign Relations. Trustee and board member of various educational, financial, and business organizations.



RALPH M. PAIEWONSKY (L.H.D.) Governor of the United States Virgin Islands. Since its inception in 1961, the Paiewonsky administration has achieved significant progress for the Territory in the development of commerce, transportation, agriculture, public health, administration, and education. Notable among the Governor's many achievements is the extensive upgrading of elementary and secondary education, and the founding in 1963 of the College of the Virgin Islands.

JOHN RHODES QUARLES (L.H.D.) Attorney. Civic leader. Partner since 1937 in the firm of Ropes and Gray. Director of several commercial and financial concerns. Trustee and officer of more than a dozen schools, colleges, hospitals. Secretary and administrative board member, Tufts-New England Medical Center. President and member, board of governors, New England Medical Center Hospitals



CHARLES LONGSTREET WELTNER (LL.D.) Attorney. Elected from Georgia to the 88th Congress in 1962; re-elected to the 89th Congress. Received Democratic nomination for 90th Congress in September, 1966. Resigned nomination October, 1966, as a matter of principle involving attitudes toward civil and human rights.

LEONARD CHAPIN MEAD (L.H.D.) Educator and administrator at Tufts, 1939-. Acting president; senior vice president; provost; secretary of the Trustees of Tufts College; and professor of psychology. Formerly, research coordinator; chairman of the Department of Psychology; director of the Institute for Applied Experimental Psychology; dean of the Graduate School of Arts and Sciences. Director of the Carnegie Tufts University Self-Study. Chairman and member of many research panels in human engineering for the United States armed forces; member of church, social and civic organizations.
