HOUSE RESOLUTION

to provide for the speaker of the house of representatives to APPOINT A COMMISSION TO RECOMMEND A LAW GOVERNING PUBLIC SMOKING POLICY AND TO ADDRESS THE PROBLEM OF EMPLOYMENT discrimination against shokers and hon-shokers.

NOW THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH CENERAL .

ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT there is hereby created a special commission to study and recommend a law or laws governing public amoking in the State of Arkansas and to study and address the problem of employment discrimination sgainet amokors and non-amovers. The commission shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and shall consist of one (1) member from the Arkaness Department of Health, one (1) member from the Arkansas Chamber of Commerce, one (1) member from the Arkansas Medical Association, one (1) sember from the . Arkansas Tobacco Daslers Association, one (1) smoker to be appointed from the

public, one (1) non-smoker to be appointed from the public, and one (1)

representative from the ALF-CIO.
