In early October, I travelled to Massachusetts along with Jim Savarese to hold discussions about the formation of a progressive tax group in the state, and to attend the State AFL-CIO annual convention.

During the trip, we had the opportunity to meet with several key labor leaders to assess their interest in promoting a fair tax message, and in opposing any cigarette excise tax increases. In conjunction with their efforts, the convention delegates approved a resolution opposing tobacco and other excise taxes. They also approved a resolution committing the AFL-CIO to promoting a graduated income tax structure for the state.

We must work quickly to build a coalition in the state backed by labor and other progressive groups to voice their opposition to the \$.25 increase in the cigarette tax.
