23 Upon reading the verified complaint for injunctive relief
24 on file in this action, the supporting declarations and the points
25 and authorities filed therewith, and it appearing to the satisfaction
26 of the Court therefrom that this is a proper cause for granting an

1 Order to Show Cause;

2 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Defendants
3 and Respondents City of San Mateo, Richard B. DeLong, as City
4 Manager of the City of San Mateo, Arthur N. Koron, as Fire Chief
5 of the City of San Mateo, their officers, agents and employees, and
6 each of them, are ordered to appear before this Court, at the Hall
7 of Justice and Records, Redwood City, California, in the Law and
8 Motion Department, November 19, 1982, at 9:00 a.m.
9 or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, then and there
10 to show cause, if any they have, why they and their officers,
11 agents, and employees should not be enjoined and restrained during
12 the pendency of this action from enforcing or threatening to
13 enforce "Employment Agreements" signed by Plaintiffs and Petitioners;
14 from requiring other job applicants in the Fire Department of the
15 City of San Mateo to sign "Employment Agreements"; from requiring
16 any job applicant to sign any agreement without first meeting,
17 conferring and endeavoring to reach agreement with Plaintiff and
18 Petitioner Local 2400; and from refusing to offer employment to
19 successful firefighter job applicants on grounds of nepotism.
