insert:

Section 10. (1) No person may advertise or promote by any means any alcoholic beverage or cigarette or tobacco product.

(2) Any person who violates the provisions of subsection (1) commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083, Florida Statutes. In addition, the person shall pay to the Department of Education a fine as follows: for the first violation, \$500; for the second violation, \$1,000; for the third and subsequent violations, \$2,000 for each violation.

(3) Money collected from the fines imposed under this section shall be deposited into the Addictions Education Trust Fund which is hereby created within the Department of Education and shall be administered by that department. The department shall use the moneys in the trust fund to provide grants for anti-smoking and anti-drinking educational programs in public schools.
