A bill to be entitled
An act relating to firefighters; amending s.
633.34, F.S.; requiring a person who applies
for a job as a firefighter to be a nonuser of
tobacco or tobacco products; providing an
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (6) is added to section 633.34,
Florida Statutes, 1988 Supplement, to read:

633.34 Firefighters; qualifications for employment.--

Any person initially employed as a firefighter must:

(6) Be a nonuser of tobacco or tobacco products for at
least 1 year immediately preceding application, as evidenced
by the sworn affidavit of the applicant.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
law.

SENATE SUMMARY

Adds the requirement to the qualifications for employment
as a firefighter that an applicant for the position must
have refrained from using tobacco or tobacco products for
at least 1 year immediately preceding application.
